JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION – GERMAN SHORTHAIRED POINTERS, SIBERIAN HUSKIES

NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE & OPEN CLASS DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS FOR SIBERIAN HUSKIES ONLY:

Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show;

Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show;

Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 816-3776. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show.

SPECIAL NOTICE – CLUSTER OBEDIENCE TRIAL – SIBERIAN HUSKIES

With the approval of the American Kennel Club, Obedience Trial classes at the OKC cluster will be consolidated to provide maximum efficiency in scheduling and judging. The Judging Program will include a complete list of breeds to be judged, and the order in which they will be judged. All Specialties in this Cluster that are offering Obedience Classes will be judged together. Each dog will be judged and individual scores recorded in the respective breed's judge's book. For the group exercises in Obedience, all breeds will be judged in one group. If there are more dogs competing than can be spaced four (4) feet per dog on one side of a ring, some must be judged in another group. The judge will divide the class into equal sections and the group exercise will be judged after each section. Following completion of group exercises, the judge will complete the judge's books for all dogs entered in each Obedience class in the respective breed's judge's book. Ribbons and awards will then be awarded by breed. Qualifying points in Obedience are based on the number of dogs in each breed only.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)**GENERAL RULES – FOR CLUB-SPECIFIC CONDITIONS & FEES, REFER TO YOUR BREED'S SECTION**

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and their produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed, or some other non-regular class.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at the time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a Brace, is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising **EACH BRACE** must be so designated – "Brace No. 1," Brace No. 2," etc.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch or Brace Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS REGARDING CORRECTIONS OR CHANGES TO ENTRIES: Corrections other than the specific changes listed in Ch. 11, Sec. 6 (i.e. sex of a dog, transfers between age specific classes, and "move-up's" to BOB or BOV) are the only changes to the entries superintendents or secretaries are authorized to make after closing of entries. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. **THIS RULE IS BEING STRICTLY ENFORCED BY THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB. PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES CAREFULLY.** Corrections to entries may be made by the Superintendent prior to the closing of entries if such correction is submitted in writing. Exhibitors are required to report any changes/corrections after closing directly to the American Kennel Club.

Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes

SWEEPSTAKES – Open to Siberian Huskies, 6 mos. and under 18 mos. on the day of the show. Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in a regular class at this show. Specific Sweepstakes Classes must be given on entry blank in space marked “Additional Class” as Sweepstakes Dog or Bitch and proper age classification. The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches: Puppy (6 mos. & under 9 mos.); Puppy (9 mos. & under 12 mos.); Junior (12 mos. & under 15 mos.); Junior (15 mos. & under 18 mos. Champions may enter.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES – Open to all Siberian Huskies at least 8 year of age and older on the day of the show. Neutered or spayed dogs are eligible to compete in Veteran Sweepstakes. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular or veteran classes at the published entry fee. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for “Additional Class.” The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches: Veterans (8 yrs. & under 11 yrs.) and Veterans (11 yrs. & older).

ANIMALS IN VEHICLES

Should the on-site veterinarian determine that any dog enclosed in a vehicle is in danger, the show committee reserves the right to break into that vehicle. Anyone parking in the show site parking areas must accept full responsibility for damages should this occur.

GROUND RULES

Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up after his own dog(s). Pooper-scoopers will be placed around the show grounds for your convenience. If your dog soils in the show ring, the ring steward will hold your dog while YOU do the clean-up. A pooper-scooper will be placed outside each ring. Responsible dog owners will clean up after their dog(s). PARENTS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES! NO SKATEBOARDS, ROLLERBLADES, SCOOTERS OR BIKES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. Grooming and exercise pens in DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. Crates may be brought to ringside during breed judging and must be removed immediately when judging for that breed is over. NO GROOMING OR SMOKING UNDER SHADE TENTS OR IN AISLES.



– NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS –

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee and a 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.00 shall be required for each entry of each dog. (Rally Regulations, Ch. 1, Sec. 3).
- CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.
