

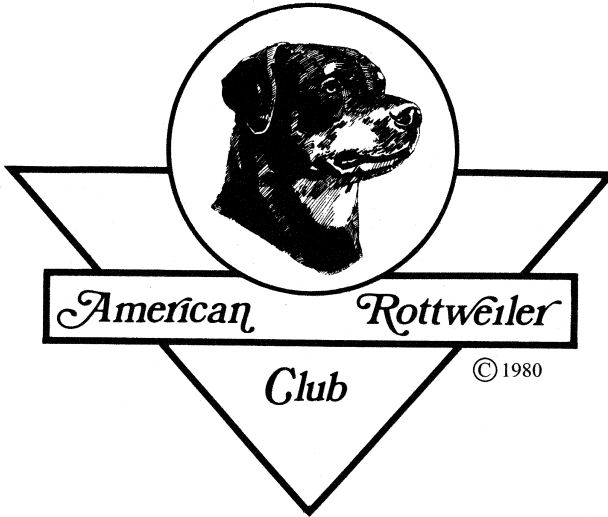

### NOTE – NEW BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

- All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be *individually registered* with the AKC. •
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog AND an owner of record of the dog. •
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder AND owner of record. •

### Non-Regular Classes (Involving single dog entries)

Veteran Dogs I      Veteran Bitches I

*A class for dogs and a class for bitches 7 years of age and under 10 years of age*

Veteran Dogs II      Veteran Bitches II

*A class for dogs and a class for bitches 10 years of age and over*

Winners of the Veteran classes, if otherwise undefeated at this show, are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition.

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION:** The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

**JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT:** All dogs eligible for Best of Breed competition shall be considered for these awards. At the discretion of the intersex judge, the maximum number of Awards of Merit that may be given shall be 10% of the Best of Breed entry, including Veterans and Winners. That 10% is in addition to the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed winners, with no consideration as to sex.

### Non-Regular Classes (involving multiple dog entries)

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its Breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class. An entry fee of \$25.00 will be charged for the Stud Dog if he is NOT entered in one of the Regular Classes, Non-Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition. Entry fee for Stud Dog as an additional class is \$17.00.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Same rules as Stud Dog.

**BRACE CLASS:** For two Rottweilers with identical ownership. Dogs need not be entered in another class. Entry fee for Brace as a Unit is \$17.00. If either dog is not entered in another class, the fee for the Unit is \$25.00.

*NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, not one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

### EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

If it is necessary to rescue a dog from a parked vehicle on the show grounds or in the parking area, the club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the vehicle involved.

PRIZES: Trophies, Ribbons, Certificates, or other prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog, who shall be considered the owner or agent. Please advise the Show Secretary of any discrepancy at once. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. No prizes will be mailed.

## OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATION

### Regular Classes (for Rottweilers only)

Novice Class A • Novice Class B • Open Class A • Open Class B • Utility Class A • Utility Class B

*Refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations for a complete definition of each regular obedience class.*

*No refund will be given for bitches that come into season after entries close.*

### Non-Regular Classes (for Rottweilers only)

*All Non-Regular Obedience Classes will be assigned to the available judge after entries close. Non-Regular Class scores are not eligible for Special Obedience Trial Awards, nor will qualifying scores be awarded AKC legs or points toward Obedience Trial Championships. Refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations for a complete definition of each non-regular obedience class, except Graduate Open Class listed below.*

**Veterans Class:** The veterans' class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least seven years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Novice class. Dogs may be entered in a regular obedience class.

**Graduate Novice Class:** The Graduate Novice class is for dogs that have not been certified by a judge to have received a third qualifying score toward a CDX title prior to the closing of entries. Dogs entered in Graduate Novice may also be entered in one of the Novice or Open classes.

**Graduate Open Class:** The Graduate Open Class is for dogs that have not been certified by a judge to have received a third qualifying score towards a UD title prior to the closing of entries. The owner or any other person may handle the dogs in this Class. The owner or any other person may handle the dog in this class. A person may handle more than one dog in this class. The dog may be entered in one of the Open or Utility Classes. Judging will be as in the regular classes. The exercises, maximum scores and order of judging: Signal Exercise – 40, Retrieve on the Flat – 20, Retrieve over the High Jump – 30, Directed Retrieve – 30, Drop on Recall – 30, Broad Jump – 20, Moving Stand and Examination – 30. Maximum Total Score...200.

**Brace Class:** For two dogs capable of performing the Novice exercises. A separate entry form must be completed for each dog comprising the Brace with a single entry fee. Indicate class as “Brace – Obedience.” Refer to fee schedule on Page 3.

### **OBEDIENCE SWEEPSTAKES**

Obedience Sweepstakes is open to all Rottweilers which, on the day of the sweepstakes, will be at least six months of age, and has not earned the title of OTCh. Entry in regular obedience class is NOT a requirement to enter Obedience Sweepstakes. A dog may be entered in a class, even if they have already earned the equivalent title in AKC, unless they have earned a leg toward the next title. If even one leg has been earned, the dog must compete at the next level. For example, a dog that has earned a CD title may compete in Novice, unless they have earned one or more qualifying scores in the Open class. Non-regular classes not available. All exercises shall be performed and judged the same as in regular AKC obedience classes for Novice, Open and Utility. Decision of the judge is final.

**Obedience Sweepstakes Prizes:** High in Sweepstakes Trial, Reserve High in Sweepstakes Trial and First through Fourth High Score in each class, shall be awarded a Rosette.

**Prize Money will be awarded as follows:** After a 35% deduction for expenses, 10% will be divided equally between High in Sweepstakes Trial and Reserve High in Sweepstakes Trial. Remaining fees will be divided as prizes within the classes as follows: First prize 40%; Second prize 30%; Third prize 20%; Fourth prize 10%.

**Added Prize Money:** High in Sweepstakes Trial shall receive a \$200 cash award. Reserve High in Sweepstakes Trial shall receive a \$50 cash award.

### **SWEEPSTAKES**

The Sweepstakes is open to all Rottweilers who are 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on Friday, August 15, 2003. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes MUST be also entered in a Regular Class. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Indicate “Sweepstakes” and age division on the regular entry form under Additional Classes. Entry fee is \$17.00.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class/Open Junior Class: **At least 10 and under 14 years old**

Novice Senior Class/Open Senior Class: **At least 14 and under 18 years old**

**NOVICE**: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 10 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN**: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 10 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**JUNIOR HANDLERS** who win a third Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from Novice Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half hour prior to the schedule start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

**JUNIORS PLEASE NOTE**: All Junior Handlers are required to have an AKC number, contact AKC (212) 696-8281 or (212) 696-8240 for information. Also, all information required on both the front and back of the official AKC entry form must be included. **BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE** in the Junior Showmanship Classes. **AT A SPECIALTY SHOW** each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. **WINNING FIRST PLACE** in an Open Junior Showmanship Class at this show may qualify, or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on the eligibility requirements for Limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved by AKC, write to AKC, Show Plans, 51 Madison Ave., New York, NY 10010.

**– NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –**

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Shows and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule. Chapter 11, Section 2).
- CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Show Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
