**From I-5 North:** Take Exit #182 to I-405 Southbound, follow it south to Exit #14-A to Hwy 520 East to Redmond and follow directions below **“From I-405.”**

**From I-5 South:** Take Exit #154 to I-405 Northbound, follow it north to Exit #14 to Hwy 520 East to Redmond and follow directions below **“From I-405.”**

**From I-90 East:** Take Exit #10 to I-405 Northbound and follow direction below **“From I-405.”**

**From I-405 -** Take Exit #14 for Hwy 520 East to Redmond. Go east on 520 for approx. 5 miles to the W. Lake Sammamish Parkway exit. Take the right of the 2 lanes on the exit ramp and turn right at traffic light onto W. Lk. Sammamish Pkwy. Immediately move to the left turn lane and turn left at the traffic light into Marymoor Park. Follow the main road and look for Show/Parking signs.

### PARKING RULES

On site parking is a privilege extended by the Sammamish Kennel Club and the Sammamish Kennel Club reserves the right to withhold this privilege from any person who does not observe the rules and/or instructions of Parking Personnel on duty. Abusive language and other tactics will not be allowed and anyone unable to abide by the rules will be escorted off the premises without recourse or refund of fees. Anyone blocking the fire lanes, illegally parking in handicapped parking, driving/parking inside the show limits or tying up the load/unload zone will pay a fine of \$100.00 and will be towed away at the owner's expense and risk.

- The Load/Unload Zone has a 15-MINUTE LIMIT. PLEASE OBSERVE!
- Handicapped parkers must have and display a current/valid state handicapped permit or vehicular license plate. We have limited handicapped parking and the loading zone CANNOT be used as an alternative.
- There are NO HOOK-UPS for overnights. There will be NO discharge of ANY liquid on the grounds. Violation will cause immediate ejection from the grounds with no recourse or compensation.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE: Should the on-site veterinarian determine that any dog enclosed in a vehicle is in danger, the Club reserves the right to break into that vehicle. Anyone parking in the show site parking areas must accept full responsibility for damages should this occur.**

### – NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

- A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Only dogs eligible for this show will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.
