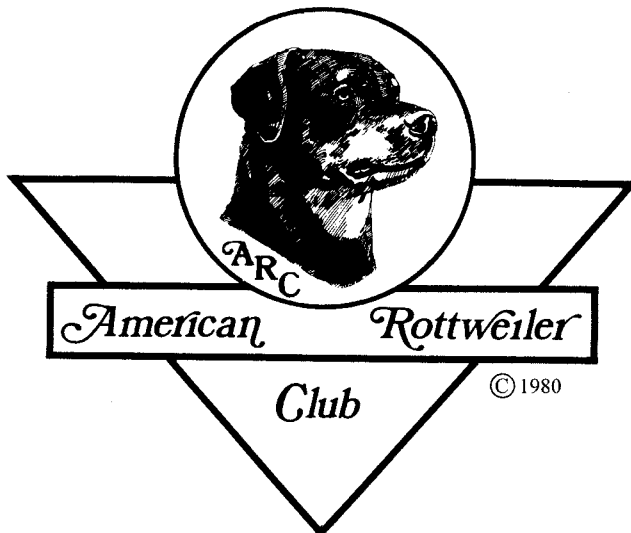

Entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet stating the number of pages, what shows and how many dogs per show. Visa, MasterCard, and American Express are accepted for Fax entries. All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog AND an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder AND owner of record.

Spayed or Neutered animals are eligible for the Veterans Classes. Winners of the Veteran classes, if otherwise undefeated at this show, are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT: All dogs eligible for Best of Breed competition shall be considered for these awards. At the discretion of the intersex judge, the maximum number of Awards of Merit that may be given shall be 10% of the Best of Breed entry, including Veterans and Winners. That 10% is in addition to the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed winners, with no consideration as to sex.

Non-Regular Classes (involving multiple dog entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its Breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class. An entry fee of \$28.00 will be charged for the Stud Dog if he is NOT entered in one of the Regular Classes, Non-Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition. Entry fee for Stud Dog as an additional class is \$20.00.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Same rules as Stud Dog.

NOTE: *As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, not one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

Both Northbound and Southbound on I-5: Take the Auburn Exit (Hwy 18). Go to Auburn and take the Enumclaw Exit to Hwy 164. Follow the signs to Enumclaw (Hwy 410). Just before Enumclaw, turn right on 244th. Go to 456th and turn left (it becomes Warner). Stay on Warner to Enumclaw Expo Center (formerly King County Fairgrounds). **Going South on I-405 or from the Renton area:** Go East on Maple Valley Highway (Hwy 169). Go through Black Diamond. Continue on until 416th Street. Turn left, then follow signs to Enumclaw Expo Center (formerly King County Fairgrounds).

PRIZES: Trophies, Ribbons, Certificates, or other prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog, who shall be considered the owner or agent. Please advise the Show Secretary of any discrepancy at once. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. No prizes will be mailed.

OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATION

Regular Classes (for Rottweilers only)

Novice Class A • Novice Class B • Open Class A • Open Class B • Utility Class A • Utility Class B

Refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations for a complete definition of each regular obedience class. No refund will be given for bitches that come into season after entries close.

Non-Regular Classes (for Rottweilers only)

Non-Regular Class scores are not eligible for Special Obedience Trial Awards, nor will qualifying scores be awarded AKC legs or points toward Obedience Trial Championships. Refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations for a complete definition of each non-regular obedience class, except Graduate Open Class listed below.

Pre-Novice Class: The Pre-Novice class shall be for dogs that have not received a third qualifying score in a Novice class prior to the closing of the trial. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises will be scored as in the Novice class, except the dogs will perform all exercises on leash, which should be long enough to provide adequate slack.

Veterans Class: The veterans' class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least seven years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Novice class. Dogs may be entered in a regular obedience class.

Graduate Novice Class: The Graduate Novice class is for dogs that have not been certified by a judge to have received a third qualifying score toward a CDX title prior to the closing of entries. Dogs entered in Graduate Novice may also be entered in one of the Novice or Open classes.

Graduate Open Class: The Graduate Open Class is for dogs that have not been certified by a judge to have received a third qualifying score towards a UD title prior to the closing of entries. The owner or any other person may handle the dogs in this Class. The owner or any other person may handle the dog in this class. A person may handle more than one dog in this class. The dog may be entered in one of the Open or Utility Classes. Judging will be as in the regular classes. The exercises, maximum scores and order of judging: Signal Exercise – 40, Retrieve on the Flat – 20, Retrieve over the High Jump – 30, Directed Retrieve – 30, Drop on Recall – 30, Broad Jump – 20, Moving Stand and Examination – 30. Maximum Total Score...200.

Exhibitors – Please read Rally Regulations carefully. Determining eligibility of a dog in any rally class rests solely with the person entering the dog.

SWEEPSTAKES

The Sweepstakes is open to all Rottweilers who are 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on Friday, August 17, 2007. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes MUST be also entered in a Regular Class. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form under Additional Classes. Entry fee is \$20.00.

PARKING INFORMATION

- **All parking is at user's own risk. Olympic Kennel Club, Enumclaw Expo Center and J.I.F.Y.S. assume no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle or its cargo.**
- Everyone using this facility is expected to keep and leave the area clean.
- Limited handicap parking (with a valid permit) is available in the general parking areas. These spaces will have easy access but may be some distance from the show rings.
- All vehicles must vacate the premises no later than one hour following Best In Show Sunday, August 19, 2007.
- **No vending in parking areas without a permit.**
- All parking fees must be paid in U.S. funds.
- **FIRE LANES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES. Vehicles subject to towing at owner's expense with no prior notification.**

Loading & Unloading

General Parking

Overnight Reserved Parking

- Reservations must be post marked on or before Wednesday, August 1, 2007.

- The AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch.11, Sec. 2). In accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC.
- CANADIAN CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS MUST BE MADE PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.
