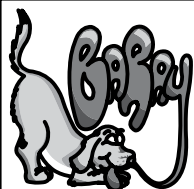

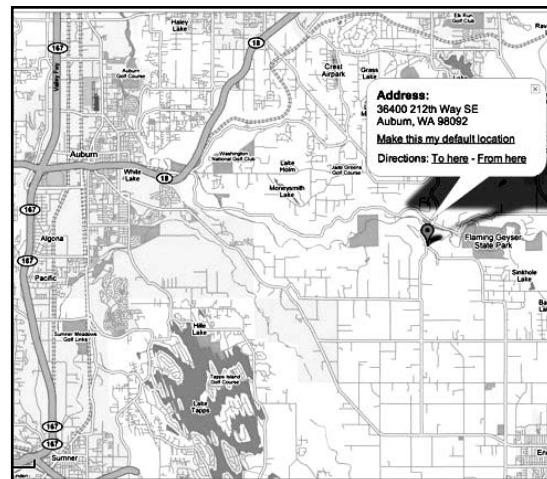

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

WARNING – DO NOT USE MAPQUEST THEIR DIRECTIONS ARE WRONG!

FROM I-5, OR SR-167: Take Hwy. 18 eastbound. Exit onto Auburn-Black Diamond Rd. eastbound. Turn Right onto SE Green Valley Rd. (just past Neely Mansion). Follow approx. 7.5 miles. Turn Right onto 212th Way SE (right after green bridge sitting on land at right). Take first Left into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

FROM SR-169 NORTHBOUND: Turn Left onto SE Green Valley Rd. (in front of the Boondocks Nursery). Go approx. 4 miles. Turn Left onto 212th Way SE. Go over the cement bridge (Whitney Bridge). Take first left into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

FROM SR-169 SOUTHBOUND: Turn Right onto Roberts Dr. (in front of the coal car). Go approx. 4 miles. Turn Left onto 218th St. At bottom of the hill is a stop sign. Go straight across over cement bridge (Whitney Bridge). Take first Left into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

FROM HWY. 410 OR WA-164: Turn Left on 244th Ave SE (approx. one mile out of Buckley). Go Straight at light on SE 436th Way/WA-164. Go Straight at stop sign (SE 416th St.). Go Straight at stop sign (SE 400th St.). Turn Left at stop sign onto SE 384th St. Turn Right at stop sign on 212th Way SE. Turn Right at Argus Ranch sign (just before bridge). Follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

DIRECTIONS TO EMERGENCY VET 718 AUBURN WAY N., AUBURN, WA

Start out going SOUTH on 212TH AVE SE toward SE GREEN VALLEY RD. Turn SHARP RIGHT onto SE GREEN VALLEY RD. Turn LEFT onto SE AUBURN BLACK DIAMOND RD. Merge onto WA-18 W via the ramp on the LEFT. Take the WA-164 E exit toward AUBURN. Turn RIGHT onto AUBURN WAY S. End at 718 Auburn Way N Auburn, WA 98002-4332. Estimated Time: 19 minutes Estimated Distance: 10.19 miles

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: BECAUSE OF TRAVEL TIME TO THE SHOW SITE, TRANSFER OF ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON THURSDAY, MARCH 26. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A dog who has earned a title after entries have closed may be moved up to the next class, provided the transfer request is presented to the Superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Move-ups may be approved provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

– NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

- **RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.**
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. - Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **TROPHIES & PRIZES** will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog. No awards will be mailed.
