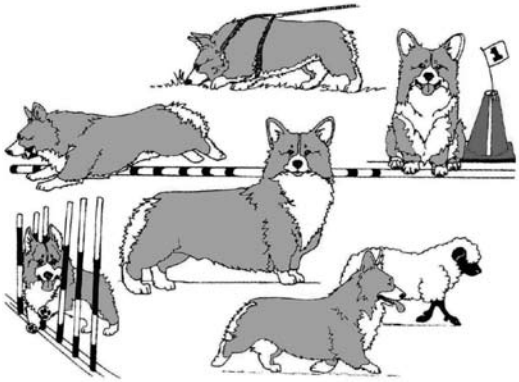

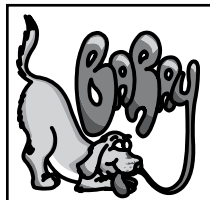

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

FROM I-5 NORTH OR SOUTH – take Hwy 16 North to Bremerton. At Bremerton take Hwy 3 north to Silverdale. Exit at Newberry Hill Road. Turn right. Follow Newberry Hill Road (becomes Silverdale Way) to Bucklin Hill Road. Turn right. 0.13 miles on right.

FROM BREMERSON FERRY – Depart ferry onto Washington (becomes 11th). Follow to Warren, turn right. Warren becomes Wheaton Way. Follow out of Bremerton to Fairgrounds Road. Turn left. Follow to Tracyton Blvd. Turn right and go to light at Bucklin Hill Road. Turn left. Go to the bottom of Bucklin Hill Road. The hotel on is the left before the light at Silverdale Way.

FROM BAINBRIDGE ISLAND FERRY – Depart ferry through town. Follow about 10 miles through Poulsbo to Hwy 3. Follow signs south to Silverdale/Bremerton. At Silverdale follow signs to East Bremerton via Waaga Way. Exit at Central Valley Rd. Follow to Fairgrounds Rd. Turn right. Go to the end of Fairgrounds Rd. and turn right at Tracyton Blvd. Go to light at Bucklin Hill Rd. Turn left. Go to the bottom of Bucklin Hill Road. The hotel on is the left before the light at Silverdale Way.

FROM KINGSTON FERRY – Take Bond Rd NE out of Kingston to Hwy 3. From Hwy 3 Take exit 45 for WA 303 toward Bremerton/Silverdale. Turn right at WA 303/NE Waaga Way. Continue on Kitsap Mall Blvd NW. Turn right at Silverdale Way NW. Turn left at NW Bucklin Hill Rd. The hotel is on your right.

Pre-reservations are closed. Rooms have been released to the general public and they will be offered on a space availability basis. The room rate of \$97.00 will be good for occupancy August 6th-12th. Mention Cascade Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club when making reservations.

RULES FOR THE SILVERDALE BEACH HOTEL

1. Dogs must be crated in guest rooms at all times, especially when owners are not in the room. NO EXCEPTIONS! Plastic is required under all crates. This is to be provided by the dogs owner. You are responsible for any damages. No ex-pen setup allowed in the rooms.
2. There will be a \$25.00 non-refundable deposit, per owner, per room. Each room will be inspected prior to checkout and if extra cleaning is needed or damage has been done, the cost will be incurred by the guest. All bedspreads will be removed from rooms prior to check in.
3. NO dogs are to be bathed or groomed in the rooms at any time.
4. Dogs must be leashed, crated or penned at all times outside your room, except when showing in obedience.
5. There is a maximum of 4 dogs per room.
6. Dogs must be cleaned up after. Please contact the hotel's front desk if you need to clean up inside the hotel or your room. Minimal clean up supplies will be furnished to you by the hotel. You will be responsible for any additional cleaning and/or supplies. Hotel and Hotel Liaison representative shall be notified and shall inspect room after cleanup.
7. No dogs are permitted in restrooms, restaurant or pool areas. Observe and Obey Signs - some areas of the hotel are off limits to dogs. Please respect posted signs and staff directions regarding designated areas.
8. The grooming area will be on the blacktop area located east of the building.
9. The hotel will provide a water source near the designated bathing area. Cascade will provide a bathing tub.
10. Tents (canopies) for shade or foul weather may be setup on grass or hard surfaces as needed. No permanent tie down stakes/holes shall be placed in paved or concrete surfaces. Only weights or sand bags shall be used for these surfaces.
11. Outdoor exercise areas must be picked up by owners after use by their dogs. Scoopers or (Preferably) plastic baggies need to be deposited in designated trash cans only.
12. No dog "marking" is permitted. Please be constantly aware of the natural territorial instincts and don't allow dogs to urinate on walls, furniture or décor or other inappropriate indoor/outdoors or furnishings. If you have an accident, don't ignore it. Ask for assistance in obtaining cleaning supplies immediately.

PLEASE NOTE: Silverdale Beach Hotel has requested that we NOT have alcohol in the grassy areas that flow off the hospitality room. Please keep your alcoholic beverages on the paved porch areas, in the hospitality room and in your own hotel room, it is fine for everyone to use the grassy area for food and non-alcoholic beverages. We encourage all participants to abide by the rules of the hotel.

RV PARKING RV parking is \$30.00 per night, including electricity. If guests are staying in the hotel, parking is complimentary. Please call the hotel to reserve your spot.

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A dog who has earned a title after entries have closed may be moved up to the next class, provided the transfer request is presented to the Superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Move-ups may be approved provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.
