THE FOLLOWING GROUNDS RULES WILL BE ENFORCED

- The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 2:00 pm, Thursday, August 13, 2009. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday, Aug. 16, 2009.
- There will be NO loading or unloading of crates/dogs at ring side during show hours! Loading and unloading will be at the Livestock Barn ONLY on Friday – gate opens at 6:00am. Grooming will be available in the Livestock and Horse Barns.
- No vehicles will be allowed on the show grounds after 7:00am on Friday unless they have reserved parking.
- There will be NO day parking on the fairgrounds.
- Power Outlets – Use of ALL power outlets is at user's own risk.
- No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
- No dogs to be left overnight in grooming building.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up after his own dog(s). Pooper-scoopers will be placed around the show grounds for your convenience. If your dog soils in the show ring, the ring steward will hold your dog while YOU do the clean up. A pooper-scooper will be placed outside each ring. Responsible dog owners will clean up after their dog(s).
- PARENTS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES!
- NO SKATEBOARDS, ROLLERBLADES, SCOOTERS OR BIKES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- Grooming and exercise pens in DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. Crates may be brought to ringside during breed judging and must be removed immediately when judging for that breed is over.
- NO GROOMING OR SMOKING UNDER SHADE TENTS IN AISLES. ALL CRATES MUST BE REMOVED FROM RINGSIDE 15 MINUTES AFTER SHOWING.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Animals left in vehicles will be monitored by County Control Officers and Club Members. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner cited.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class. *NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The Dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION (Papillons & Pomeranians)

NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 816-3776. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Jr. Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Jr. Showmanship Only fee applies.

CATALOG ADVERTISING GUIDELINES

HARD COPY ADS: All text must be typewritten or legibly printed. Photos should be photographic quality, not printed from an inkjet or bubblejet printer.

SPECIAL NOTICE – CLUSTER OBEDIENCE TRIAL & CLUSTER RALLY TRIAL

Obedience Cluster: Maltese & Pomeranians • Rally Cluster: Papillons

With the approval of the American Kennel Club, Obedience Trial classes at the OKC cluster will be consolidated to provide maximum efficiency in scheduling and judging. The Judging Program will include a complete list of breeds to be judged, and the order in which they will be judged. All Specialties in this Cluster that are offering Obedience Classes will be judged together. Each dog will be judged and individual scores recorded in the respective breed's judge's book. For the group exercises in Obedience, all breeds will be judged in one group. If there are more dogs competing than can be spaced four (4) feet per dog on one side of a ring, some must be judged in another group. The judge will divide the class into equal sections and the group exercise will be judged after each section. Following completion of group exercises, the judge will complete the judge's books for all dogs entered in each Obedience class in the respective breed's judge's book. Ribbons and awards will then be awarded by breed. Qualifying points in Obedience are based on the number of dogs in each breed only.

The Club will offer two Awards of Merit to be awarded at the Judge's discretion to those dogs who were in serious contention for Best of Breed.

PARADE OF COMPANION AND RESCUE MALTESE

There will be a Parade of Companion and Rescue Maltese at the close of the conformation judging. Exhibitors who wish to show their beloved pet companions, or a Maltese who has been rescued from any situation where the dog was unwanted – regardless of whether or not these dogs are or have been shown in any competition – may do so. Each exhibitor of Companion and Rescue Maltese who brings the dog into the ring and shows it will receive a Medallion with the Evergreen Maltese Club logo. The entry fee is \$10.00. Entrants in this category may bring a brief, typed or legibly printed statement (50 words or less) about the dog they will be showing to be read by the announcer as the dog is exhibited in the ring.

PARADE OF VETERANS

There will be a Parade of Veteran Maltese. The Sweepstakes judge will invite the Veterans to enter the ring, and the name of each dog in the Parade will be announced. After the Parade, the Judge will present each participant with a Medallion with the Evergreen Maltese Club logo. Entry fee \$10.00

PARKING INFORMATION

General Information

- All parking is a privilege extended by the Olympic Kennel Club, Inc. & the Enumclaw Expo Center. Any arguing, abusive language or failure to follow the rules, regulations or instructions of the club or parking personnel will cause you to be escorted from the show site, forfeit all parking privileges without refund of fees & possible discipline by the Event Committee.
- **All parking is at user's own risk. Olympic Kennel Club, Inc., Enumclaw Expo Center & J.I.F.Y.S. assume no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle or its cargo.**
- Everyone using this facility is expected to keep & leave the area clean.
- Limited handicap parking (with a valid permit) is available in the general parking areas. These spaces will have easy access but may be some distance from the show rings.
- All vehicles must vacate the premises no later than one hour following Best in Show on Sunday, August 16, 2009.
- **No vending in parking areas without a permit.**
- All parking fees must be paid in US funds.
- **FIRE LANES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES. Vehicles subject to towing at owner's expense with no prior notification.**

Loading & Unloading

- Reserved Grooming is in the Livestock Building located at the northeast corner of the grounds. Free day grooming is in the Horse Barn located southeast of the Livestock Building. Vehicle access to both buildings will be off 284th Avenue SE - follow signs.
- Unloading will begin at 2:00 pm Thursday, August 13, 2009. All loading & unloading will be supervised & a time limit per vehicle will be observed to give as many exhibitors as possible access to the grooming building.

General Parking
