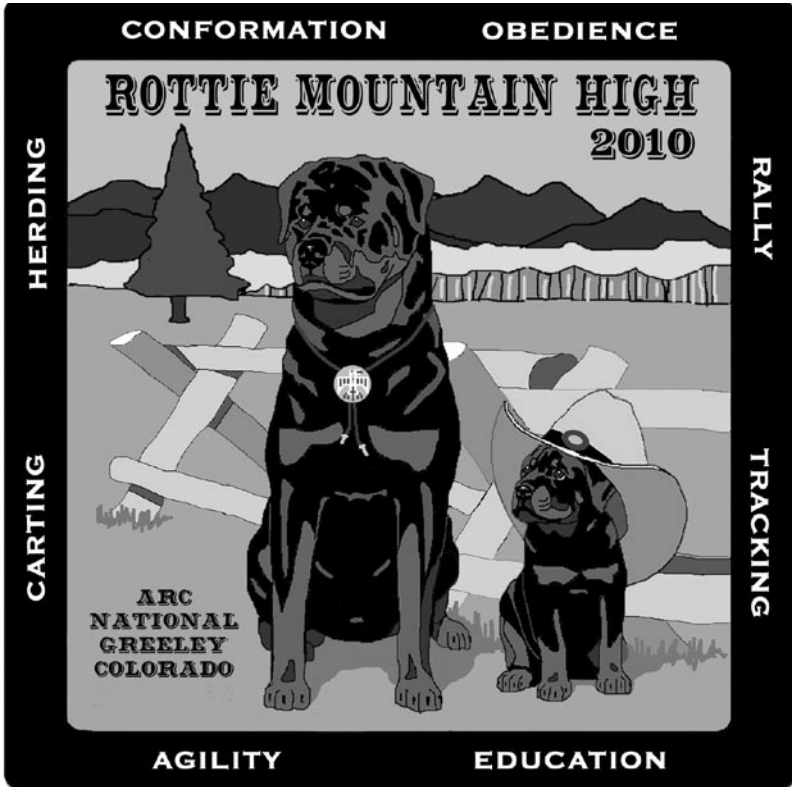

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

Highway 85 going North – Take Hwy 34 Bypass west 1 ½ blocks to 11th Ave. Turn right (N) on 11th Ave. Proceed N on 11th Ave. approximately 5 miles to the Island Grove Park Entrance. High 85 going South. Right before you get to the Highway 85 Bypass on the North end of Greeley, you will turn R on 'O' Street (aka Rt. 64) The 1st street you will cross is 11th Ave. Turn L and go S to the Island Grove Park Entrance.

DIA Airport – leave the airport traveling W on Pena Blvd. You will exit at 6B. This exit is the Tollway – check with your rental agency regarding HOW you pay for your tolls. Stay on tollway heading to Ft. Collins (15 miles). You will exit for Interstate 215, follow this exit heading N to Ft. Collins. Traveling on I-25 you will go approximately 30+ miles to Greeley Exit -257A (Hwy 34) going E. Follow Highway 34 E. If you are staying at any hotel on Hwy 34 stay on this road. If you are staying at Microtel you will want to get off at the Greeley Business Exit, this highway becomes 10th St. To get to Host Hotel (Clarion) proceed on 10th St. until you get to 8th Ave. Turn L, hotel is one block N or the right.

Traveling I-25 N or S – Take Exit 257A (Hwy 34) going E. Follow directions given above to get to hotels. **In Greeley**, Avenues run N & S with the lowest #'s on the E and the highest #'s running to the West. Streets run E & W with the lowest #'s on the N & the higher #'s running South. The main N & S streets are Hwy 85 By-pass, 8th Ave., 11th Ave., & 23rd Ave.

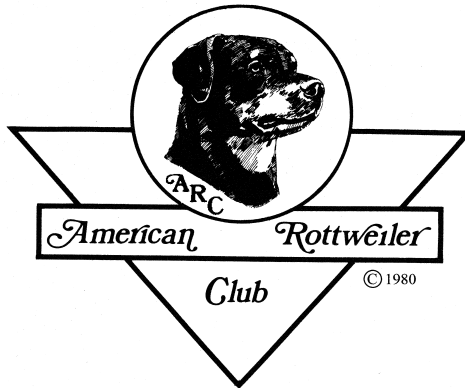

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

***NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE BARAY EVENTS OFFICE
AFTER 12:00 NOON ON THURSDAY, APRIL 15. AFTER THIS TIME,
YOU MUST CONTACT THE SHOW SECRETARY ON SITE.***

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, provided this transfer must be made to the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A dog who has earned a title after entries have closed may be moved up to the next class, provided the transfer request is presented to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Move-ups may be approved provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

HOTELS

NOTE: You are required to clean up the area after walking your dogs (on leash) at any hotel/motel. Do not leave dogs unattended in your room. Do not groom dogs inside any room. Exhibitors will be subject to disciplinary action by the show committee for any reported abuse of hotel/motel property. Remember to verify if these facilities accept pets, policies change.
