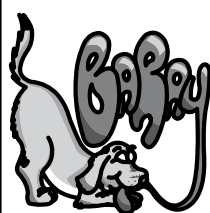

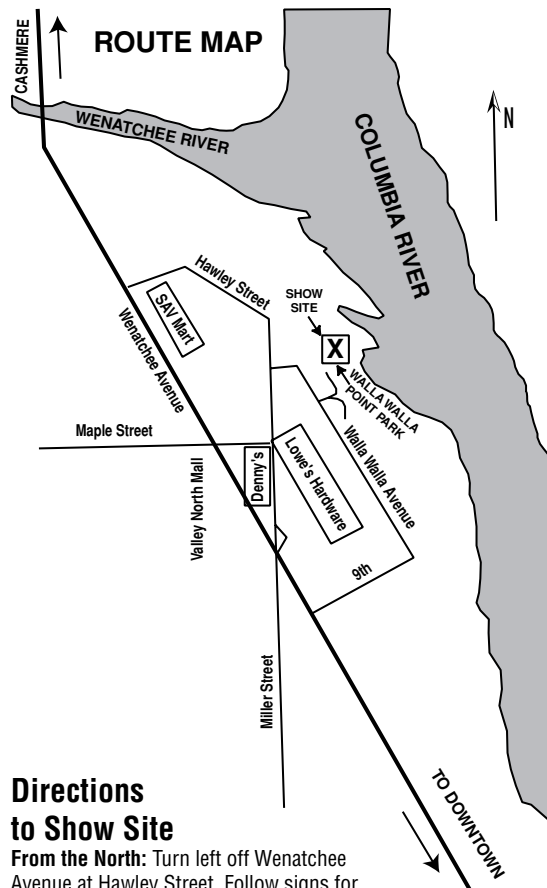

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: BECAUSE OF TRAVEL TIME TO THE SHOW SITE, TRANSFER OF ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 Noon ON THURSDAY, SEPT. 16. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another. provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A dog who has earned a title after entries have closed may be moved up to the next class, provided the transfer request is presented to the Superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Move-ups may be approved provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

USE OF RAMPS

At the sole discretion of the judge, approved breeds may be examined on the ground or on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Whippets, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden, and Polish Lowland Sheepdogs. Whippets may be examined on the ground, on a table or on a ramp. Basset Hounds are expected to be judged on the ramp during breed judging. For the judging of Juniors, the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp breeds. This list may be revised from time to time, and the current list can be found on the AKC website in Judging Operations. A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the day of the show. AKC approval is not required. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

VENDORS

Concession space at these shows is open to any vendor for the retailing of dog-related supplies and services. All vendor space is outside with no cover. All vendors operate at their own risk and must sign an agreement releasing the Wenatchee Kennel Club, Inc. and the Chelan County P.U.D. (park operator) from any liability or responsibility for damage or injury arising out of these events. Dogs kept in vending area must be in ex-pens or crated. Gates will close at 11:00 p.m. Friday & Saturday. Premises MUST be vacated by 8:00 p.m. Sunday, September 19, 2010. **Parking personnel** will help you in finding your space. They will not reassign spaces. **NO ELECTRICAL HOOKUP AVAILABLE. OVERNIGHT PARKING WITHOUT RESERVATION: \$70.00 FLAT FEE. EXTRA VEHICLE: \$10.00 FLAT FEE.** PARKING FEES ARE TO BE PAID IN U.S. FUNDS. Be advised only ONE sleeping Unit in one reserved space.

OVERNIGHT PARKING EXHIBITORS – PLEASE READ

The Parks Department that maintains the Walla Walla Park in Wenatchee has informed the Wenatchee Kennel Club that this will be the last year we can hold the Dog Show at this park unless damage to the Ball Fields is dramatically reduced. Therefore these are rules that will be enforced.

1. Very large motor homes may be parked on the Northeast asphalt parking lot.
2. All recreational vehicles that use stabilizing jacks are required use at least an 18 inch by 18 inch board or equivalent between the Jack and the grass to prevent putting holes in the grass.
3. No exhaust from generators or the vehicle engine should be pointed to the grass for any length of time. Generator exhaust needs to be vented upward. In other words do not burn the grass from generator or engine exhaust.
4. Do not dump any liquids on the grass. If you use a bucket with Chlorine or Pine Sol type water for pooper scoopers, do not dump on the grass.
5. If your dog digs while in an exercise pen, then put down a mat or other barrier to prevent destroying the grass.
6. Ball Field 4 at the Northwest corner will only be used for overflow vehicles to reduce ruts in Ball Field 3 in the Southwest corner.
7. We may require extra vehicles to be parked in the day parking lots.
