*All Regular & Non-Regular Breed Classes and Junior Showmanship*

I acquired my first Cavalier King Charles Spaniel as a puppy in 1987, and consider myself extremely fortunate that just before her second birthday in 1989, "Circe" became BISS Ch. Martell's Enchantress of Martindale. For the past 23 years we have bred and shown many of our Cavaliers to their (AKC and CKCSC) championships, in addition to having multi-National and Regional Specialty Best of Breed and Award of Merit winners. Without a doubt our most success in the show ring was with AKC & CKCSC Ch. Annatika Andreas ("Andy"). Andy's English breeders, Jenny and George MacAlpine, entrusted us with our once in a lifetime Cavalier in October 1998. Mrs. Shealagh Waters (Maibee) awarded Andy Best of Breed at the 1999 ACKCSC National Specialty. Mr. Brian Claydon (Brymarden) selected Andy for Best of Breed at the CKCSC National in 2000, and later that year at COPS' second Specialty Andy went Best of Breed under Mrs. Pauline Sidgwick (Paulian). When we retired Andy from the show ring in 2002 he held the all-breed Best in Show record in the U.S., as well as being the only three-time Westminster Kennel Club Best of Breed winner. While not a prolific stud dog, Andy sired numerous multi-champion litters for our kennel (HMS), as well as for other breeders. We lost Andy in November of 2009, at 14-1/2 years old, however his special presence and spirit continue to be strongly felt at HMS as he is behind all of our current family of Cavaliers.

As a founding member of the American Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, I have served as a past co-chair of our breed's Judges Education committee. I am a past President, Vice-President and Treasurer of Nor-Cal Toy Dog Fanciers and of the Bay Area Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club. Before beginning judging conformation and Jr. Showmanship for AKC in 2005, I enjoyed teaching conformation and junior handling classes, and had the pleasure of judging Sweeps at the 2003 COPS Specialty. Four years ago my partner Kim Murphy and I relocated from the San Francisco Bay Area to Rayne, Louisiana, where we are active members and officers of the Acadiana KC. I wish to thank the Cavaliers of Puget Sound for the invitation to adjudicate at your 2010 Specialty, and I look forward to another wonderful day with you all and your lovely Cavaliers.

**Erica Venier** (Orchard Hill Cavaliers) .....1053 Faller Ln., Leesport, PA 19533  
*Puppy Sweepstakes*

I began breeding and showing dogs while still in high school, developing into a serious exhibitor by 1974 with a Shetland Sheepdog bitch, the Working Group winner Ch. Sandmere Mollie Malone, C.D. I continued to breed and show Shelties on a limited basis while my children were young, producing several champions under the kennel name Wits' End. By the mid-nineties, I was ready to devote more time to my passion and bought my first Cavaliers. I am completely captivated by the breed; the endearing qualities of these dogs are a daily source of pleasure. My daughter Rachel Venier works with me, brainstorming breedings and training youngsters. Together we have bred well over fifty Champions in three breeds, the majority of which have been Cavaliers. Among our most notable Cavaliers have been the National Specialty winners Ch. Pinecrest Orchard Hill Rock The Boat, Ch. Orchard Hill Easier Said and the 2009 National Best Puppy in Show, Ch. Orchard Hill Ingenue.

**Christopher Cornell** ..... 62 Bon Jon View Way, Sequim, WA 98382  
*All Regular & Non-Regular Obedience and Rally Classes*

Teaching basic manners to my son's gift from his grandparents, a rambunctious English Setter puppy, introduced our family to the world of obedience in 1976. After attending a couple of beginner classes and getting Queen under some kind of control, I got more interested, training intensified, and a new hobby was born. In 1980, Queen became the first English Setter to earn the OTCH title.

Over the years, we have trained English & Irish Setters, Flat-Coated Retrievers and Labrador Retrievers. Currently, we have a yellow Lab (Mercedes), a Heinz 57 (Jamie) and an English Springer (Junior), along with foster dogs coming and going. Two of our own dogs started as foster dogs, and ended up staying permanently. We have raised two Lab puppies for Guide Dogs for the Blind. I started judging obedience at AKC shows in 1984. My wife Claire and I lived in Phoenix, AZ for many years until I retired in 1999. We then moved to our new home in Sequim. We love it up here, have an irrigation pond with ducks, geese, coots, hawks and eagles, and a fantastic view of the majestic Olympic Mountain Range. We are now confirmed northwesterners. In 2000, Claire and I organized a therapy dog club and we visit a number of retirement homes, assisted living and Alzheimer facilities, a local hospital and have a reading program with children at the local library and five elementary schools. I have been on the Board and was Past-President of the Hurricane Ridge Kennel Club and currently serve as the Obedience/Rally Chairman.

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

Grand Champion Selects

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records.

**GRAND CHAMPION COMPETITION** – The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition: 1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed class. 2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. 3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.) 4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to: 1. Best of Breed or Variety 2. Best of Opposite 3. Select Dog 4. Select Bitch. Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition.

### **Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)**

VETERAN DOGS    VETERAN BITCHES

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches seven years of age and older.

*Spayed and neutered animals may be entered and shown in Veteran Classes at specialty shows. Winners of the Veterans Classes may also compete for Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.*

### **Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)**

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** Same as Stud Dog Class, except for the following two changes: Substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog," and substitute "Produce" for "Get."

**BRACE CLASS:** Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a

maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The Dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

*NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, or Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

**NOVICE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

#### **NOVICE & OPEN CLASS DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:**

**Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show;

**Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show;

**Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 816-3776. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

**NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship.**

## **SWEEPSTAKES**

### **JUDGE: MRS. ERICA VENIER**

**ELIGIBILITY:** The Sweepstakes is open to all Cavalier King Charles Spaniels, who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Sweepstakes classes will be judged prior to the regular breed classes.

**ENTRIES:** Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating in the space for "Additional Classes" your entry in Sweepstakes, and include the fee of \$13.00 per dog. ALL ENTRIES IN SWEEPSTAKES MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS AT THIS SHOW AT THE APPROPRIATE ENTRY FEE.

### **DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY**

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
