Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries – Samoyeds Only

Veteran Classes I – Class for Dogs and Class for Bitches 7 yrs. & under 11 yrs.

Veterans Class II – Class for Dogs and Class for Bitches 11 yrs. & older

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes.

Working Class – Class for Dogs and Class for Bitches. Dogs and bitches must be registered with AKC. ILP numbers are accepted. Dogs may not be neutered and bitches may not be spayed. Entrants must have a Samoyed Club of America Working Dog Title, either WS, WSX or WSXM, or any other AKC performance title (i.e., to include but not be limited to Obedience, Agility or any other AKC performance title). Entry fee \$18.00. *Winners of both Veteran Classes and both Working Classes (except dogs with ILP numbers), if otherwise undefeated at this show, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed.*

Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dog and two, but not more than four, of his Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with his Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Entry Fee for UNIT is \$22.00. If Stud Dog is entered in another class at this show, Entry Fee for the UNIT is \$18.00.

Brood Bitch Class – For Brood Bitch and two, but no more than four, of her Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown with two or more of her Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of Produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. Entry Fee for UNIT is \$22.00. If Brood Bitch is entered in another class at this show, Entry Fee for the UNIT is \$18.00.

Brace Class (Two, identical ownership) – The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a Brace, is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." If either dog comprising the Brace is not entered in another class at this show, Entry Fee for UNIT is \$22.00. If both dogs comprising the Brace are entered in another class at this show, Entry Fee for UNIT is \$18.00.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

PARADE OF TITLEHOLDERS – SAMOYEDS ONLY

Eligibility: Any AKC, SCA or CKC Champion of Record or Title Holder (i.e. Obedience, Tracking, Herding, Weight Pull, Agility, Temperament, Working Samoyed or Working Samoyed Excellent) may be entered for the Title Parade only. Each Samoyed participating in the Title Parade will receive a Rosette with the dog's name imprinted in gold on a streamer. Notation must be indicated on entry form along with the Dog's Title/Titles. Entry fee \$15.00. Persons entering dogs should bring a typed 3" x 5" card with dog's registered name, dog's call name and owner's name, dog's titles and a short listing of his major wins and/or accomplishments (Specialty or All Breed Best of Breed, Group Wins, Awards, HIT, etc.) to be read when the dog appears in the ring. Information limited to one side of card only. Information card must be turned in at the show before start of Parade to the Ring Steward.

SWEEPSTAKES – SAMOYEDS ONLY

The sweepstakes is open to all Samoyeds who are 6 months and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form under "Additional Classes." NO PUPPY BORN AFTER FEBRUARY 13, 2004, will be eligible for this Sweepstakes. Dogs entered in the Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club. Entry Fee is \$18.00.

Layout and assignment of spaces will be handled by J.I.F.Y.S. exclusively – do not contact OKC regarding parking requests. RV parking prices are \$25 per night pre-reserved. Tow vehicles are an additional \$15 for the whole weekend. Checks should be made payable to OKC and mailed to J.I.F.Y.S. There will be a \$20 charge for returned checks. Check-in will begin at 4PM on Thursday. Overnight parking check-in will be in the North Parking Lot.

ANIMALS IN VEHICLES

Should the on-site veterinarian determine that any dog enclosed in a vehicle is in danger, the show committee reserves the right to break into that vehicle. Anyone parking in the show site parking areas must accept full responsibility for damages should this occur.

GROUNDS RULES

Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up after his own dog(s). Pooper-scoopers will be placed around the show grounds for your convenience. If your dog soils in the show ring, the ring steward will hold your dog while YOU do the clean-up. A pooper-scooper will be placed outside each ring. Responsible dog owners will clean up after their dog(s). PARENTS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES! NO SKATEBOARDS, ROLLERBLADES, SCOOTERS OR BIKES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. Grooming and exercise pens in DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. Crates may be brought to ringside during breed judging and must be removed immediately when judging for that breed is over. NO GROOMING OR SMOKING UNDER SHADE TENTS OR IN AISLES.

– NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- Effective for events held on and after January 1, 2004, the AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Chapter 11, Section 2).
- **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS**
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.**
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS**. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made.
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY BASIS**.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW**. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP SUBSTITUTION OF DOG.** There will be an Administrative Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show.
- Only dogs eligible for this show will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.
- **ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED** after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Superintendent at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.

It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.
