## LOADING AND GROOMING

There will be NO loading or unloading of crates/dogs at ringside! Loading and unloading will be at the Livestock Building ONLY. Grooming areas will be available in the Livestock and Rabbit Buildings. Drive-thru gates to the show grounds will open at 6AM and will close at 8PM. Walk-thru gates will be open 24 hours. Parking outside the show grounds is available after 8PM. No vehicles will be allowed on the fairgrounds after 7PM.

## SETUP

Setup of tents/equipment may NOT be within 15 feet of any rings.

All tents/equipment must be removed within one (1) hour of the conclusion of the Specialty Show. Rings and area MUST be left clean.

## PARKING

There will be NO day parking on the fairgrounds. RV Parking will be handled by J.I.F.Y.S., PO Box 187, Boring, OR 97009. Layout and assignment of spaces will be handled by J.I.F.Y.S. exclusively – do not contact OKC regarding parking requests. RV parking prices are \$25 per night pre-reserved. **BEST OF BREED COMPETITION:** The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

### BEST PUPPY IN THE PUPPY CLASSES

#### Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

**STUD DOG.** For Stud Dogs and at least two and no more than four of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class. Entry fee is \$23.00 for the Unit, or \$17.00 as an additional class.

**BROOD BITCH.** For Bitches and at least two and no more than four of their produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class. Entry fee is \$23.00 for the Unit, or \$17.00 as an additional class.

**BRACE CLASS (Two dogs, identical ownership).** The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be a part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". Full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes - "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be so designated "Brace #1", "Brace #2", etc.

*NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, or Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

All dogs and bitches entered in Sweepstakes MUST ALSO be entered in a Regular Class at this Specialty, at the regular entry fee. The Sweepstakes is open to all OLD ENGLISH SHEPDOGS who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. **ENTRY FEE:** \$13.00 for each dog and bitch entered in Sweepstakes in addition to regular entry fee. Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating in the space for "Additional Classes" your entry in Sweepstakes. – NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- Effective for events held on and after January 1, 2004, the AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Chapter 11, Section 2).
- **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS**
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.**
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS**. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made.
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY BASIS**.
