– NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch. 11, Sec. 2). The AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee (AKC Rally Regulations, Ch. 1, Sec. 3). A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for the AKC.
- **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U. S. FUNDS**
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS AND CORRECTNESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.**
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS**. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made.
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY BASIS**.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW**. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED** after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Superintendent at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving single dog entries)

Veteran Dogs I & Veteran Bitches I – *A class for dogs and a class for bitches 7 yrs and under 10 yrs.*

Veteran Dogs II & Veteran Bitches II – *A class for dogs and a class for bitches 10 yrs. & under 12 yrs.*

Veteran Dogs III & Veteran Bitches III – *A class for dogs and a class for bitches 12 yrs. & older
Dogs/Bitches entered in any Veterans Class may be spayed or neutered.*

Coursing Dogs Coursing Bitches

A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches who are AKC registered and are confirmed Field Champions, Coursing Champions or Coursers of Merit. NOTE: Exhibitors must supply proof of eligibility for this class with the entry. (A copy of the certificate awarding the title or a copy of the ENTIRE PAGE from either the AKC Gazette or Field Advisory News magazine publishing the title will be accepted as proof). Dogs/Bitches will not be entered into this class without proof of title accompanying the entry form. First place winners in this class are eligible for Best of Breed Competition providing all AKC eligibility requirements have been met. NOTE: No Championship Points are awarded for this class.

Winners of the above classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete in Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from date of show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

JUDGE'S AWARD OF MERIT: At the conclusion of the regular Best of Breed judging, the judge may at his/her discretion, award an Award of Merit (AOM). The judge is not obligated to award an AOM, if s/he feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. The total number of AOMs the judge is allowed to award is dictated by the total number of dogs and bitches competing in the Best of Breed competition, which shall be one AOM for each seven entered. A Rosette is offered for this award.

Non-Regular Classes (involving multiple dog entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and at least two and not more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its Breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a Brace, is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Brace Class." The price for this class (as a Unit) is \$12.00 in addition to any other fees paid for the individual dogs..

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch or Brace Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES – BOTH DAYS

To stimulate interest in the showing of young and older Salukis, a Sweepstakes and a Veteran Sweepstakes will be held in conjunction with the Puget Sound Saluki Club Specialty Shows. Classes will NOT be divided by coat (i.e., Smooth or Feathered).

General Rules – Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes

Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" or "Veteran Sweepstakes" (stating AGE/CLASS) in the space for "Additional Classes." Dogs need not be owner/handled, but handlers who usually charge a fee for their services will not be allowed in the ring unless they own the dog being handled. This includes employees and immediate family members. Entry fee is \$12.00 for each dog and bitch entered in the Sweepstakes, in addition to any regular entry fee.

Distribution of Funds – Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes

Sweepstakes and Veteran Sweepstakes are separate entities

and prize money will be distributed according to the entry in each Sweepstakes.

50% of Total Entry Fee will be retained by the Puget Sound Saluki Club for expenses. Winners of each class will compete for the remaining 50%, which will be awarded to the first for placements as follows: First Prize – 40% • Second Prize – 30% • Third Prize – 20% • Fourth Prize – 10%

SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes is open to all Salukis who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. All dogs and bitches entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the Regular Classes at the regular fee.

CHALLENGE TROPHIES

The following Challenge Trophies are offered through the Puget Sound Saluki Club for competition at its Specialty Shows only. For permanent possession, Challenge Trophy must be won three times by the same owner and/or breeder, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. BEST OF BREED: "The Reba Memorial Trophy" is offered in memory of Ch. Bel S'mbran Bachrach, Ch. Reina del Bel S'mbran, and their first champion daughter, Ch. Bel S'mbran Reba al Ahmar, and is offered by Mary Dee Lindemaier, Shamar Acres. The Trophy, produced by Garry Newton, consists of a seven-inch circle Bronze Bas Relief Medallion (#1 of 25) mounted on walnut. The Medallion depicts a Saluki in a circle within a circle, representing the human life cycle interacting with that of the Saluki. The Saluki is highlighted by the serene shading of the blue green background.

BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES: "The Rassidy," a mounted Silver Bowl, offered by George & Sally Bell, Bel S'mbran Kennels.

BEST VETERAN FROM THE VETERAN CLASSES: "The JR Memorial Trophy" is offered in memory of Ch. Bel S'mbran JR, offered by Steve and Dianna Kass of Tamazar Kennels. The trophy mount is a wood base that is layered broad to narrow with a large silver bowl sculpted with grapes and leaves.
