PARKING INFORMATION

Parking for this weekend is a privilege extended by WWAH and Argus Ranch Facility. WWAH and ARF reserve the right to withdraw this privilege from any person who abuses it. OBEY ALL PARKING SIGNS. All parking staff are volunteers. Thank you for treating them with courtesy. Abusive language towards the parking attendants may result in dismissal from the show.

- Parking is at your own risk. Neither WWAH, ARF, the Specialty Clubs nor the Superintendent assumes any responsibility or liability for damage or loss to any vehicle, its contents or dogs.

- All parking is to be on the show grounds.

- Gates will open at 6:30 AM and close at 11:00 PM Friday thru Sunday.

- Unloading in designated areas only. Observe all time limits.

DAY PARKING: No charge Friday. SATURDAY & SUNDAY \$5.00. Parking Field--Enter on 212th Way SE.

HANDICAP PARKING: Enter in Parking field off of 212th Way SE.

LOAD/UNLOAD: Enter Parking field for rings 2,3, & 4 or Main Gate for rings 1,5 &6.

OVERNIGHT PARKING: At the gate \$50.00 CASH per nite (no guarantee of space). CANADIAN exhibitors Note: Fees must be paid in US dollars or check drawn on a US bank account. You may NOT mark "pay in US funds" as our bank will NOT process these checks. Contact parking chair with any questions.

- RV map with overnight assigned spaces at Main Entrance. If you arrive late, please find your assigned space number next to your name.

- All RVs must be self contained. Anyone dumping gray water/sewage on grounds will be subject to a \$500.00 fine.

- Generator times: 6 AM to 10 PM QUIET Hours 10PM-6 AM

PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO ELECTRICITY AVAILABLE AT THESE SHOWS

With the exception of paid overnight parking spaces, there will be no electricity available at these shows. To accommodate exhibitors who wish to use their own portable power generators for grooming, there will be a first-come, first-served grooming area designated for this purpose (generators may not be used outside of the designated grooming area). This grooming area will be within walking distance of the rings, but will not be directly on the field where the show rings and main grooming areas are located in respect of fellow exhibitors. Please help protect the future use of our beautiful show grounds. Bring your own shade.

CANOPIES FOR SHADE ARE ALLOWED but, per AKC rules, must be positioned 10 feet from any ring. A clear walkway will be maintained around the rings. **THERE IS NO SHADE ON THESE GROUNDS. Please bring your own shade and chairs.**

USE OF RAMPS – HOUND BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group judging, Cirneco dell'Etnas and Norrbottenspets (Misc.) may be judged on the ground or on a ramp. Whippets may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table.

Basset Hounds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (01/2016)

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00NOON, THURSDAY, AUG 1. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.
