Do not use Lake Holm Road. It has load restrictions and tight turns that make it impossible for an RV.

From I-5 or Highway 167: Take Highway 18 heading EAST. From Highway 18 (either direction), take the Auburn Black Diamond exit. At the stop sign, turn Right onto Auburn Black Diamond Road. Continue on Auburn Black Diamond Road for 7.6 miles until you get to intersection of 218th Avenue SE. Turn Right and cross SE Green Valley Road. Argus Ranch will be on your left.

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: BECAUSE OF TRAVEL TIME TO THE SHOW SITE, TRANSFER OF ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 5PM ON THURSDAY, JULY 30. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship class at the show.

PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO ELECTRICITY AVAILABLE AT THESE SHOWS

With the exception of paid overnight parking spaces, there will be no electricity available at these shows. To accommodate exhibitors who wish to use their own portable power generators for grooming, there will be a first come, first served grooming area designated for this purpose (generators may not be used outside of the designated grooming area). This grooming area will be within walking distance of the rings, but will not be directly on the field where the show rings and main grooming areas are located in respect of fellow exhibitors. Please help protect the future use of our beautiful show grounds. Bring your own shade.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE Animals left in vehicles will be monitored. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner cited.

CANOPIES FOR SHADE ARE ALLOWED but, per AKC rules, must be positioned 10 feet from any ring. A clear walkway will be maintained around the rings. **THERE IS NO SHADE ON THESE GROUNDS.** Please bring your own shade and chairs.

2015 PARKING INFORMATION - OVERNIGHT RESERVATIONS CLOSED

Parking for this weekend is a privilege extended by WWHA and Argus Ranch Facility. WWHA and ARF reserve the right to withdraw this privilege from any person who abuses it. **OBEY ALL PARKING SIGNS. All parking staff are volunteers. Thank you for treating them with courtesy.** Abusive language towards the parking attendants may result in dismissal from the show.

- All parking is to be on the show grounds
- Gates will open at 6:30 AM and close at 11:00 PM Friday thru Sunday
- Unloading in designated areas only. A time limit per vehicle will be observed.
- Handicap parking: both day and overnight spaces will be available on a limited basis. Proof of eligibility is required.

HANDICAP PARKING: Enter in Parking field off of 212th Way SE
LOAD/UNLOAD: Enter Parking field for rings 2,3, & 4 or Main Gate for rings 1,5 & 6

OVERNIGHT PARKING: "Day of Arrival" \$50.00 per nite (no guarantee of space)

- All RVs must be self contained. Anyone dumping gray water/sewage on grounds will be subject to a \$500.00 fine.
- Generator times: 6:00AM to 10:00PM. QUIET Hours 10:00PM-6:00AM
- Power/water requests are on a *first come, first served* basis. There are spaces available with power/water hookups some distance from the rings. All reserved parking that is close to ringside DO NOT have hookups.
